# Pennsylvania Avenue Southeast Corridor Study

Led by the District Department of Transportation (DDOT), the Pennsylvania Avenue Southeast corridor project (Penn Ave Southeast) is a transportation planning study focused on improving safety and mobility for bicyclists, pedestrians, transit and vehicular travel along this east/west connection from the west side of the Sousa Bridge to 2<sup>nd</sup> Street SE near the U.S. Capitol. The project's development has been shaped by previous studies, recommendations, public involvement and input.

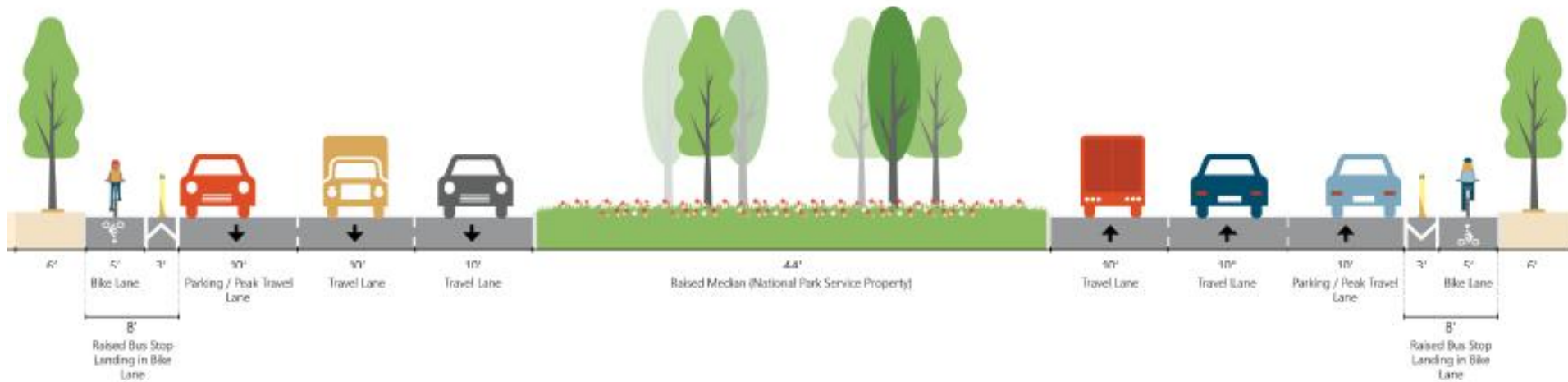
